## RULES

**Exhibitors submitting entries for this Show are requested to read and abide by the Rules laid out below.**

**These Rules will be strictly adhered to.**

All Affiliated Classes will be judged under the Rules of WPCS.

### Entries/Fees

£3.00 per Class for Ceredigion Association Members (for 2010)

£6.00 per Class for Non-Members of Ceredigion Association

£1.50 per Class for all Young Handlers

- No Entry will be accepted without the prescribed Fee. No Entry will be accepted except on the official Entry Form. Entry Forms received without the appropriate Fee will be returned
- No telephone/e-mail entries will be accepted
- Cheques/Postal Orders made payable to "Ceredigion Welsh Pony & Cob Association"
- All entries to be sent to the Show Secretary (see Entry Form) on or before the official closing Date (see Entry Form)
- No refund/s of Entry Fee/s will be considered unless a written request is received and accompanied by a Veterinary Certificate.

**Closing Date for ALL entries: TUESDAY, 1<sup>st</sup> JUNE, 2010**

To ensure the printing and availability of a Catalogue **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Medals will be awarded subject to the conditions laid down by the WPCS. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving reasons for doing so.

### Rosettes

Rosettes awarded 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> place. Rosettes for all competitors in Young Handler classes.

### Exhibitors Numbers

Numbers to be collected on Show day from the Secretary's Office. Exhibitors will be responsible for ensuring that the correct number/s is/are worn in the appropriate Class/es. The Committee will not be responsible if the wearing of wrong Exhibitor number/s affects the award of WPCS Medal/s.

### Substitutions

- Substitutions or nominations of entries are not allowed.
- Substitution of handlers in affiliated Welsh Classes is not permitted without the permission of the Judge.

### Cancellation/Amalgamation

The Show reserves the right to cancel, amalgamate or divide any Class or Classes.

### Judging/Judges

The Judge's decision is final.

The Committee reserves the right to appoint a substitute Judge should the need arise. Every effort would be made to inform Exhibitors of the fact if the time scale allows.

#### **Appeal/Objection**

Any appeal from an exhibitor must be received by the Show Secretary, in writing and accompanied by the prescribed deposit of £20.00, within 30 minutes of the end of the class. In the event of an appeal being dismissed the deposit will be forfeited.

#### **Young Handler Classes**

Hard hats must be worn

Age of Handlers as on the day of the Show

Handler will be judged on his/her ability to show a pony or cob in-hand.

The ponies and cobs need not have been entered in other classes at the show.

NO colts or stallions to be shown

Entries to be made on Show Entry Form as for Show Classes.

#### **Hard Hats**

Hard Hats must be worn at ALL times when riding ponies and cobs on the showground. Where a hat comes off or the chin strap comes undone whilst competing, the competitor must, on penalty of elimination, replace it or fasten it before continuing. The exhibitor may dismount without penalty to recover the hat or have it passed up from the ground, or may stop without penalty to fasten the chin strap.

#### **Prizes/Cups**

Where Cups are awarded, these may be collected and signed for at the Secretary's Office. Cups to be returned by 1<sup>st</sup> April annually. The person signing for the Cup will be deemed responsible for its safety and return.

Where there are Prizes in Kind being awarded, these to be collected by the winner from the Secretary's Office. Any uncollected prizes at the close of the Show will be disposed of at the discretion of the Committee.

#### **Behaviour**

Any act of discourteous behaviour or ill treatment whatsoever may result in the offender being reported to his/her respective Society.

#### **Horse Boxes/Trailers**

Anyone found mucking out horse boxes/trailers or leaving litter on the Showground will be fined.

#### **Coughing**

Any horse or pony persistently coughing will be pronounced unsound and asked to leave the show field.

#### **Dogs**

All dogs must be kept on a lead at ALL times on the show field.
